# General Fund Recap Changes Uses



- Parks & Recreation project management (3.0 FTE) 320,000
  - Project manager
  - Right-of-way/land acquisition
  - Procurement liaison

Good news - Prince William County 's FY2023 budget proposal now includes three positions to acquire land and manage projects for new trail segments and parks. These were not in the original draft.

Advocacy by organizations that are members of the Greater Prince William Trails Coalition - and leadership from Supervisor Victor Angry - is creating the foundation for actually building whatever trails will be included on the trails map of the Mobility Chapter of the 2040 Comprehensive Plan.

Map is still draft; there is still time to suggest where you want trails added. Check out the Coalition's Aspirational Trails Map 2.0 to see what is missing.
